

Rev. John R. Weber, C.S.Sp.

Fr. John Weber 77, a member of the Congregation of the Holy Spirit died on January 1, 2012.

John Robert Weber was born in Washington PA on November 9, 1935. He professed his vows August 22, 1958 at Holy Ghost Novitiate, Ridgefield CT and was ordained to the priesthood October 25, 1961 at St. Mary's Seminary, Ferndale, Norwalk CT.

Fr. Weber received his first appointment in 1962 as teacher to St. Francis de Sales High School, Chicago and later Gerard High School, Phoenix until 1964. He served briefly as Assistant at St. Mark the Evangelist, NY (1966) when he was appointed teacher at St. Emma's Military Academy, Rock Castle VA until 1970. He was Assistant Pastor at Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, Polish Hill (1975-1977), and Sacred Heart Parish, Emsworth (1977-1979). He was then appointed Director of Seminarians for the Spiritans with residence at Laval House, Duquesne University until 1985.

He was a temporary Assistant at St. Mary's Parish, Detroit in 1985 followed by an appointment as Pastor of St. James, Dayton OH (1986-1993). He returned again in 1993 to Duquesne University as Vocation Director and Assistant Formation Director for the former US East Province of the Congregation. Subsequent appointments included Pastor of St. Patrick/St. Stanislaus, Pittsburgh (1995-1996), Pastor of Holy Spirit Parish, Millvale (1996-2001) as well as Parochial Vicar there (2001-2003). Fr. Weber has been a resident in retirement of Libermann Hall, Bethel Park since 2003.

Fr. Weber was preceded in death by his parents John and Mary Costanzo Weber. He is survived by his brother Don of Ocala FL.
